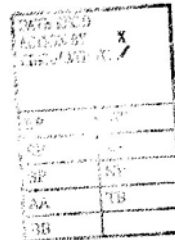

**ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1990  
 WASTE MANAGEMENT LICENSING REGULATIONS 1994: REGULATION 17  
 REGISTRATION OF EXEMPTIONS FROM WASTE MANAGEMENT LICENSING  
 TRANSFER STATIONS FOR RECYCLABLE MATERIALS AT BALTONSBOROUGH (111),  
 MARSTON MAGNA (113), GLASTONBURY (115) AND TAUNTON (116)**

Thank you for your letter dated 7 February 1996 regarding the registration of exempt activities with regard to the Waste Management Licensing Regulations 1994.

With regard to the activities carried out on site, I confirm that the following activity is exempt from the requirements of site licensing subject to the provisions stated within Schedule 3, paragraph 11, of the above regulations, specifically:-

11. Carrying on at any place, in respect of a kind of waste listed in Table 3, any of the activities specified in that Table in relation to that kind of waste where -
  - a) the activity is carried on with a view to the recovery or re-use of the waste (whether or not by the person carrying on the activity listed in that Table); and
  - b) the total quantity of any particular kind of waste dealt with at that place does not in any period of seven days exceed the limit specified in relation to that kind of waste in that Table.

TABLE 3		
Kind of Waste	Activities	Limit (tonnes per week)
Waste paper or cardboard	Baling, sorting or shredding	3,000
Waste textiles	Baling, sorting or shredding	100
Waste plastic	Baling, sorting, shredding, densifying or washing	100
Waste glass	Sorting, crushing or washing	1,000
Waste steel cans, aluminium cans or aluminium foil	Sorting, crushing, pulverising, shredding, compacting or baling	100
Waste food or drink cartons	Sorting, crushing, pulverising, shredding, compacting or baling	100

I would reiterate, however, that each proposal for an exemption from the requirement to hold a waste management licence needs to be considered on a site specific basis and that in this particular case, given the nature and source of the material together with the scale and nature of its use, the above exemption would be appropriate.

The exemption from the requirement to hold a waste management licence in relation to the above activities relates specifically to those activities as they occur to date. Should the aspects pertaining to these operations change the Waste Regulation Authority shall be informed immediately. I would also state that you will be subject to periodic inspections to ensure full compliance with the conferred exemption.

You should also have regard to your responsibilities under the "Duty of Care" legislation by ensuring waste transfer notes are provided and that any persons delivering waste are registered carriers.
